



Rehab Remodel in Progress

King's Manor became certified to provide skilled nursing services and rehabilitation for Medicare patients in August of 2010. We contract with Pro's Rehab, a very experienced company and have already seen many individuals go back home to their busy lives after a stint of rehab in the capable hands of Shelly Graham PTA, and Yvonne Coronado, COTA. Rehab is different from long-term care in that patients are often here very short term and do not bring their own furnishings, and decor as do long-term residents. Our resident rooms currently do not lend themselves for this use.

Our goal for 2012 is to create a rehab hall that is comfortable and attractive, complete with new paint, drapes, bedspreads, privacy curtains, a lift recliner and a hospital-style bed. Our 2nd Annual Dessert Auction resulted in generous donations totaling \$12,000 which were designated for the purpose of remodeling the hall. Those funds will go towards paint and décor but were not sufficient to *completely* update the resident rooms.

We have some very generous donors that are assisting us in this endeavor. Johnny and Jana Trotter's magnanimous donation will go towards the hallway itself, allowing us to put in faux wood flooring, paint, artwork and décor. Five other donors have adopted a room on the 300 hall. Each adopted room will

have new flooring, new closet doors and drawers, new bedspreads, drapes and a recliner. The work has already begun and the transformation is remarkable. It will be several weeks before the new drapes, bedding and chairs arrive. But in the meantime, progress is being made, one room at a time. We invite you to stop in and see this caterpillar as it climbs out of the cocoon. We expect to launch a full grown, glorious butterfly by May! There are 4 remaining rooms on the hall yet to be adopted, if you are interested in investing in this project.

If You Fall

How you react after a fall can cause more injuries than the fall itself. If you try to get up too quickly or in the wrong position, you may make an injury worse.

Relax, take several deep breaths and determine if you are hurt. If you believe you are injured, do not attempt to get up. Instead, call 911 or get help from a family member.

But, if you do not feel dizzy, are not in pain and feel strong enough to get up, follow these steps:

1. Roll over on to your hands and knees.
2. Crawl to a steady chair.
3. Put your strongest leg under you so that your foot is on the floor.
4. Stand up using your arms on the chair for support.
5. Sit on the chair until you feel comfortable to walk.

Be sure to let your health care provider know about your fall.

A physical or occupational therapist can teach you and the person in your care the best techniques for getting up from the floor after a fall.
