



## King's Manor is Celebrating 50 Years of Service

In going through box upon box of memorabilia collected in 50 years, we have reclaimed documents that shed meaning on the true impact of King's Manor and the people involved in this organization, either as one who shared the original dream, staff members or residents. Explaining the concept of this organization is a difficult task because King's Manor is so much more than the sum of its parts.

On March 23, 1962 at 10:00 a.m. King's Manor had a ground breaking ceremony presided over by Resident Bishop Paul V. Galloway; Superintendent of Amarillo Methodist District, Dr. V.N. Henderson; Minister of the First Methodist Church, Rev. Herschel Thurston; Minister of Wesley Methodist Church, Rev. John V. Ferguson; and Executive Director, Reverend Don Davidson. The following is reprinted from the program for the Ground Breaking Ceremony.

Declaration: Mr. William C. Young

*Dearly beloved, the building, which by the favor of God and the labor of man will be erected here, will ever be a symbol of that care*

*and concern Jesus always exhibited for the lonely, the hungry, the discouraged, and the lost. It is through Jesus Christ that we find the inspiration to undertake this task.*

*We firmly believe God, our heavenly Father, not only desires, but gladly accepts the service of comfort, companionship and security*



*which this home shall provide, and that he looks with favor upon the construction of this building to be dedicated to Him and to the welfare of his children.*

*Let us therefore, bring to Him our praises for His guidance and aid in this undertaking, and thank Him for leading this people who by their gifts and their services make*

*this day possible. May the purposes of this adventure find fulfillment in companionship for the lonely, physical security for the weary and love for the lost.*

King's Manor is owned by the Northwest Texas Annual Conference of the Methodist Church and is held in trust and managed for the Church by the Corporation known

as "Northwest Texas Methodist Homes for Older Adults, Incorporated."

The first \$40,000 used to promote a program for Home for Older Adults in the Methodist Conference was the gift of Larry and Thea Moore, and their family. Although the name "King's Manor" means

to us “the Lord’s Home” it also is of note that Mrs. Larry Moore was Thea King before their marriage. The decision to place the Methodist Home at Hereford was the outgrowth of a united community campaign led by the Business and Professional Women of Hereford, but supported by the Hereford Area Foundation personnel, and enough of the entire community to make a gift of more than one hundred thousand dollars including this excellent site for the home in appreciation for what the people of Hereford know the home will finally be.

This East Wing of King’s Manor will be ready for occupancy in the fall of 1962 and you are invited to retire to this residence for complete Christian living and care. When it is completed, it will provide creative living opportunity for almost one hundred and fifty residents, with all that science and love can provide for every need in the Golden Years of life.

A great deal has changed since 1962. For example, King’s Manor is now a free standing 501 (c)(3) corporation and is a mission of the Northwest Texas Conference. Our official name is now King’s Manor Methodist Retirement System, Inc. The name includes the word “system” intentionally to reflect the depth of service provided.

The facility began in 1962 with private pay Independent Living and Nursing Care. In 1982, the facility became licensed to accept Medicaid. The facility truly became unique in 1985 with the addition of a child care facility that has charmed both residents and staff since day one. The child care was part of the Administration Addition underwritten by, Dean Headstring, Miss Beulah Deunsing, and the Mary Bivins Foundation. This addition joined together the two sides; Westgate Nursing and the (at that time) Independent Living, Manor.

The Hereford community needed some type of in-between independent living and nursing care and thus in 1996; the facility became one of the first licensed “Personal Care” facilities, now known as Assisted Living. In December of 2004, Samaritan Hospice and Adult Day Care were licensed and in August of 2010, we became a licensed Rehab facility and began accepting Medicare.

This organization is a living breathing entity, ever changing with the needs of the community. The facility was born out of the commitment of concerned individuals and continues to grow and improve because of the deep commitment and support of the Hereford community and friends of the organization.

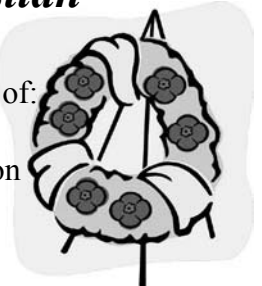
