## Westgate Activity News

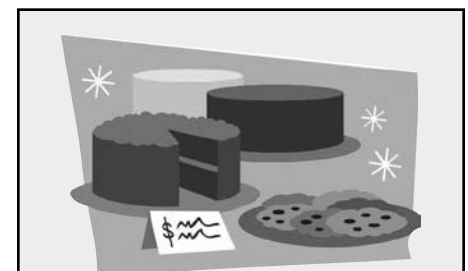

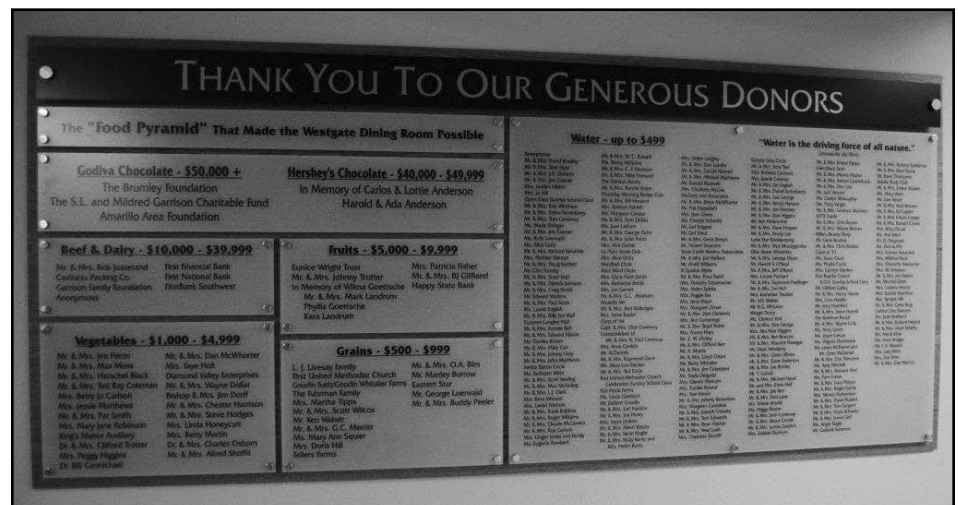
