board determines the direction, focus and values of the organization. The board members each do things individually on behalf of the organization: Board members were

instrumental in refurbishing and updating the Manor library. Janice Carr (board member "in law") volunteered her talents as librarian and did a wonderful job organizing books. Mike Carr donated new blinds and Kathy Allison provided funding through the Monsanto Fund and private donations for new paint, flooring, and furnishings. When the furniture arrives shortly, it will be totally refurbished.

The board, as a group, sponsored a room in the rehab hall which was completely refurbished as a result of their generosity. Their most recent project was the Garrison House. This project was born out of the board's desire to utilize Shirley Garrison's annual gift to the facility to add to the campus of King's Manor in a way that would honor Mr. Garrison as well as improve and expand the organization. Mr. Garrison had been a long faithful supporter of King's Manor and made a generous donation toward the down payment of a beautiful new 2-unit garden home on Sunset Drive. The board put a great deal of time and energy into the project; no detail was left to chance. They looked at floor plans and examined square footage; they chose colors, granite, flooring, and brick.

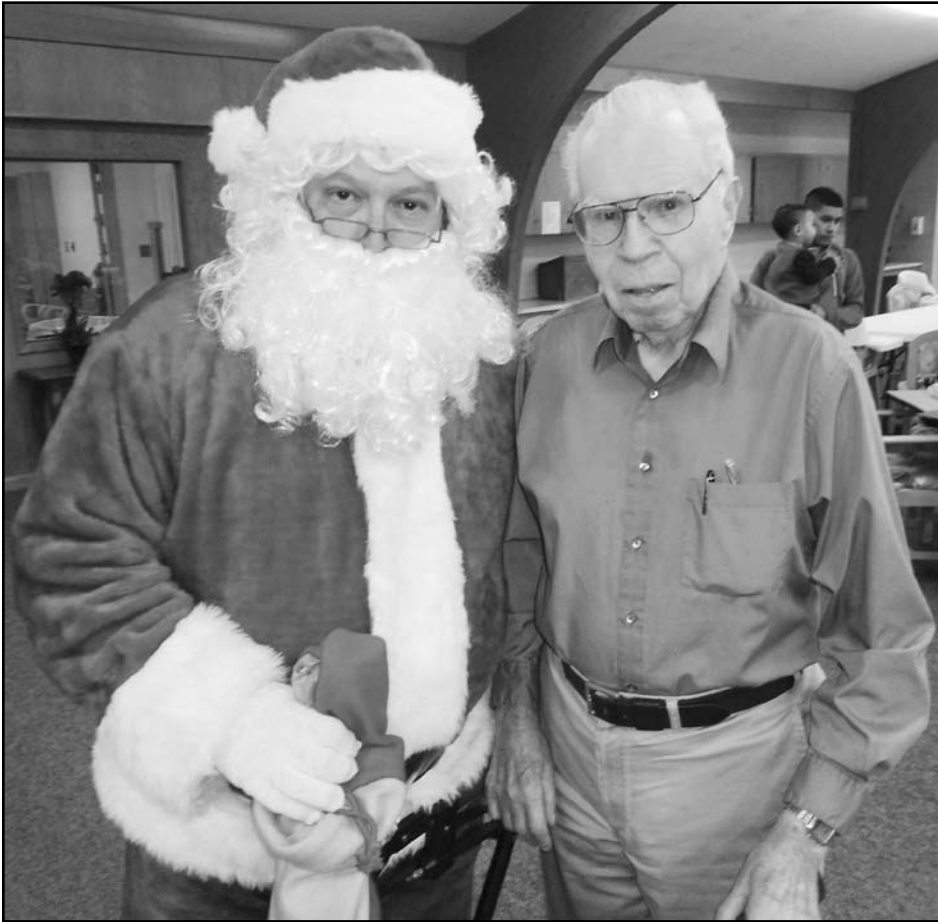
